## **TLILIC2001 – Licence to Operate a Forklift**

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to operate a forklift truck safely. Forklift truck means a powered industrial truck equipped with lifting media made up of a mast and an elevating load carriage to which is attached a pair of fork arms or other arms that can be raised 900 mm or more above the ground, but does not include a pedestrian-operated truck or a pallet truck.

Our course is a mix of theory content, practical and class participation. Assessment consists of written responses to questions and observation of practical skills.

**What you will learn:**

- ◆ Legislation and WHS requirements
- ◆ Duty of care and Safe work practices
- ◆ Hazards and risk management
- ◆ Planning your work
- ◆ Conduct routine checks on a forklift truck
- ◆ Shift loads in a safe manner
- ◆ Safely shut down and secure equipment



**Pre requisites:** Participants must all have a USI number.

Participants must be from 18 years of age and comply with the requirements outlined in the application for high risk work (GF083) published by Work Safe Tasmania.

You **MUST** wear protective work wear (safety boots) for the practical assessment.

These need to be supplied by the participant.

**Outcome:**

A statement of attainment for the unit TLILIC2001 Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck.

Successful participants are able to apply for a National High Risk Work Licence (Forklift truck) as issued by Workplace Standards Tasmania under the Work Health & Safety Act 2012. Participants have 60 days to apply for their High Risk Work Licence with Service Tas. This Licence is valid for 5 years and will then require renewal.

In Partnership with Forest Industries Skills Training (F.I.S.T) (RTO No. 60138). Whilst all training will be conducted by AJL Training Pty Ltd, all students will be enrolled with F.I.S.T. By participating in one or more of these programs you will be enrolled in units of competency relevant to the course.
