## TLILIC0003 – Licence to operate a forklift truck

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to operate a forklift truck safely. Forklift truck means a powered industrial truck equipped with lifting media made up of a mast and an elevating load carriage to which is attached a pair of fork arms or other arms that can be raised 900 mm or more above the ground, but does not include a pedestrian-operated truck or a pallet truck.

Our course is a mix of theory content, practical and class participation. Assessment consists of written responses to questions and observation of practical skills.

**What you will learn:**

- ◆ Legislation and WHS requirements
- ◆ Duty of care and Safe work practices
- ◆ Hazards and risk management
- ◆ Planning your work
- ◆ Conduct routine checks on a forklift truck
- ◆ Shift loads in a safe manner
- ◆ Safely shut down and secure equipment

**Entry requirements:** Participants must all have a USI  
Participants must be from 18 years of age and complete application for high risk work (GF083) published by V

You MUST wear protective work wear (safety boots) for assessment. These need to be supplied by the participant.

**Outcome:**

A statement of attainment for the unit TLILIC0003 Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck.

Successful participants are able to apply for a National High Risk Work Licence (Forklift truck) as issued by Workplace Standards Tasmania under the Work Health & Safety Act 2012. Participants have 60 days to apply for their High Risk Work Licence with Service Tas. This Licence is valid for 5 years and will then require renewal.
